has played a pioneering role in the development of Open Access publishing. In 2013 the bilingual Open Access journal *Pragmática Sociocultural/Sociocultural Pragmatics* was successfully launched. Since then, our OA portfolio has quickly grown to include single titles in all Romance languages, English, and German. Last but not least, we are proud to present two new bilingual OA book series: *Literaturas Latinoamericanas en el Mundo* (in cooperation with the ERC project *Reading Global*) as well as *The Dynamics of Wordplay*.

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


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
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
